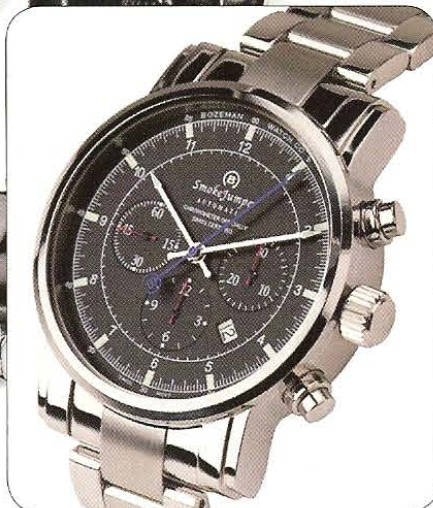

## Black Admiralty

Corum has added a new timepiece to its Admiral's Cup Collection. Though it features its recognizable twelve-sided case, the colorful nautical symbols on the flange that act as hour markers have been conspicuously toned down in this version. The Admiral's Cup Challenge 48 Black Flag comes in a 48-mm black titanium case that holds the CO-753 automatic caliber. The hours, minutes, seconds, date and chronograph functions are displayed in an all-black *côtes de Genève* dial, highlighted by iridescent blue hands and chevrons. The screw-down titanium caseback has been decorated with the Admiral's Cup trophy, and a vulcanized rubber bezel ensures extra protection from impact. With a limited run of 100 watches available in the United States, this timepiece retails for \$8,000.



## Montana Limited

Talk about limited editions. Bozeman Watch Company re-releases one unit each of its debut timepieces, the Schofield and the SmokeJumper Chronograph, which were previously unavailable. The SmokeJumper was the first watch released by the company as a tribute to the airborne fire fighters and the Schofield is a more understated watch that has an ETA Valgranges automatic movement with a date window. Price for the SmokeJumper is \$7,300 and for the Schofield is \$7,900.
